About 1900 six full-page chromotypographies were added, the first in multiple colours, the others in a single colour (other than black) (images No. 008, 027, 048, 062, 101). At about 1905 all 6 images were printed in multiple colours (same image numbers with suffixed "a"). Other variations with only three multiple coloured images exist as well. In the last edition only the images no. 027 and 062 were printed with some colour, the others were printed in black.
